



International Arbitration Training Course

The Hague, The Netherlands – 22 - 26 August 2016

The Grotius Centre for International Legal Studies at Leiden University and the Permanent Court of Arbitration, in cooperation with Leiden Law School launched an International Arbitration Training Course.
